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Overview of Jayaprithvi Multiple Campus (JMC)

Jayaprithvi Multiple Campus (JMC) was established on 1st Mansir, 2038 BS (1981 AD). It was inaugurated by Shanti Rajya Laxmi Devi Singh, the then queen of Bajhang on 10th Baisakh, 2039 BS along with the presence of the then king Deepak Jung Bahadur Singh, Gagan Jung Bahadur Singh and the founding campus chief Gajendra Bahadur Singh. It is situated in Jayaprithvi Municipality – 11, Bhopur, Bajhang, near the historic Bhopur Durbar and Satyavadi Secondary School. Similarly, it is around a kilometer faraway from Chainpur, the district headquarter of Bajhang towards the east beside the Chainpur – Taklakot Highway. It was named after the educationist, philosopher, activist, and humanitarian king, Jai Prithvi Bahadur Singh (Jayaprithvi Bahadur Singh), the National Hero of Nepal.

From its inception to 2074 BS, it was launched as a community-based public campus under Tribhuvan University (TU). Firstly, it had commenced its academic journey from Proficiency Certificate Level (PCL) i.e. Inter of Arts



(IA) under the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. This PCL journey remained singly continued over 16 years (up to 2054 BS) from its establishment. To pursue their first university degree, students

from Bajhang and neighboring districts (Bajura, Achham, Dadeldhura, Baitadi, and Darchulla) enrolled here since it was the only higher-level academic institution in the Hilly areas of the then Far Western Development Region. Furthermore, the campus authority was able to launch a Bachelor's Degree (BA) from 2054 BS along with the existing PCL degree up to 2061 BS. After that, to fulfill the diverse academic needs of the students, its authority instigated +2 in Education, Humanities, and Commerce streams in place of PCL and Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.), Bachelor of Business Studies (BBS) and Master of Arts (MA) one after another.

However, the +2 degree no longer existed on campus because of government policy. Later on, along with the decision of the Senate, Far West University (FWU) in 2070 BS, its academic trajectory tended to shift from the community-based public campus (TU) to a government-

based constituent campus. However, it was accomplished only by 2075 BS. Really, it was a historic academic shift for its people, students, affiliated Faculty, Staff, and stakeholders as a whole.

Infrastructure Development in JMC



Due to the massive earthquake with the epicenter in Bajhang on 16 Ashwin, 2080, all the academic and administrative buildings of JMC had been cracked badly, and nearly dismantled some of them. As a result, we could hardly initiate our day to day academic activities and the condition has somehow unchanged till now as well. Later on, we endeavored for its reformation and explored the way forward. To concretize our plan, Far Western University (FWU), Nepal, donated a three and half-storied multipurpose building with four rooms on each floor. Thereafter, the foundation laying ceremony was inaugurated by Mr. Yagya Raj Pathak, Registrar, FWU, on 2 Jeshtha, 2081 BS. Now, it has been under construction. Similarly, with the initiation of JMC administration, the Ministry of Physical Infrastructure Development, Sudurpashchim Province allocated 20 Lakh

Rupees for the embankment of Bhopur Khola near the campus area. For its implementation, the committee has already been



formed and construction will be started soon.

By understanding our transitional period after the massive earthquake, Nabil Bank, Bajhang granted 2 lakh forty two thousand Rupees for constructing two restrooms for boys and girls. Now, the construction has been accomplished. Similarly, our endeavors for infrastructure development will be continued in the days to come as well.

A Three-Day Academic Workshop in JMC

Research Management Cell (RMC) organized a Three-Day Academic Workshop in collaboration with the University Grants Commission (UGC), Nepal on 4 – 6 Jeshtha, 2081 BS. For the capacity building of the Faculty of JMC and 7 other campuses of Bajhang, RMC initiated this workshop entitled 'Academic Proposal and Thesis Writing Workshop'. The workshop was facilitated by Dr. Madan Singh Deuba, Faculty of Central Campus, FWU, Dr. Gyanu Raj Poudel, Faculty of Tikapur Multiple Campus and Mr. Ashok Raj Khati, former Principal, Sainik Awasiya Vidhyalaya, Atariya, as external human resources and Dr. Dipak Raj Joshi, Mr. Bhanu Bhakta Joshi and Mr. Lal Bahadur Bohara, Faculty of JMC as internal human

resources. During the workshop, 14 different sessions were presented along with the 'Experience Sharing Session concerning QAA at Tikapur Multiple Campus' with Dr. Gyanu Raj Poudel. All the sessions were chaired by different faculty from JMC and other campuses individually and overviewed critically after all. Approximately, three dozen of Faculty were benefitted from this workshop.

In the opening ceremony, Mr. Lal Bahadur Bohara, Coordinator of RMC, chaired the workshop, Dr. Bhawan Singh Chalaune, Dean, Faculty of Education, FWU as a Chief Guest, Dr. Daman Bahadur Chalaune, Director, of Research, Innovation and Development Center, FWU as a Distinguished Guest, Mr. Chet

Raj Bajal, Mayor of Jayaprithvi Municipality, as Distinguished Guest, Mr. Dirgha Raj Pandit, Campus Chief, JMC, as a Special Guest and campus chiefs of different campuses of Bajhang as guests. All of our guests delivered their best wishes and the

necessity of such programs at the university level. Finally, the program was closed along with the closing remarks of the chairperson.

With this, our students will benefit by accessing online resources (books, articles, newspapers, archives, etc.) residing in the corner of their rooms. There are many dynamic activities to initiate under both of these projects in the days to come. Both projects are led by Dr. Dipak Raj Joshi, Coordinator, QAA Section, as a focal person.

Similarly, for our library support, the Indian Embassy to Nepal donated One Lakh Rupees this year. With this amount, we bought reference books related to diplomacy, history, Indo-



Nepal relationship, and so on. For the academic enhancement of JMC, our efforts have been continued and will be more in the days and years to come.


Phone in Campaign for Students' Enrollment

feeder school, especially the students of class 11 and 12, of Bajhang during the months of Phalgun/Chaitra per year. Provision of Students Scholarship in JMC

Over a few years, we have been managing full and partial scholarships to our students as per the university rules and regulations. As per the university rules, 25% of newly enrolled Undergraduates and Graduates are liable for the scholarship. For this provision, we obey the prescribed norms of the university, and priority is given to those students who are from Dalits, Janajati, and minority communities along with poor family backgrounds. Being the majority of students are girls, we prioritize them as well. We

consider the meritocracy of the students too. Per year, the University Grants Commission (UGC), Nepal has also been providing scholarships to students, especially from the rural areas. Our students grab this opportunity as well. This year, nearly 100% of newly enrolled Undergraduates have been awarded scholarships both from JMC and UGC. For the betterment and benefit of our students, we are always eager to support them variously.

Course-Based Orientation to the Newly Enrolled Undergraduates

As every year, JMC has oriented the newly enrolled undergraduates about their academic journey to the university level this year. On dated 24 Mangsir, 2081 BS, JMC organized this event to orient the students of B.Ed. and BBS First Semester. At this event, Mr. Lal Bahadur Bohara, Assistant Campus Chief, oriented them about the academic system, key dynamics of JMC, and course conduction in detail.
